ABOUT GABRIELA MISTRAL

Lucila Godoy Alcayaga known to the world as Gabriela Mistral, was born in 1889 in the city of Vicuña. She was a self-taught educator, poet, diplomat and humanitarian. She central theme of her poems are about death and sorrow, children and her beloved Chile. She wrote extensively on behalf of the rights of children, education, women and native people. In 1945, she was the recipient of the Nobel Prize in Literature, the first Latin American to be recognized with this award and to date the only Latin American woman who holds this honor. Mistral died in 1957 in the City of New York while serving as Consul of Chile. Her writings and her work left an important mark in Chile, Latin America and the world and they are as important now as they were more than 70 years ago.
